Following the shooting is the Trial of Jack McCall. Cost to attend the trial is \$5 adults, \$3 Children and \$4 Seniors. Tour around Deadwood on Deadwood's Original Bus Tour. They start with the Ft. Laramie Treaty of 1868. Tell you about Custer's Expedition to the Black Hills, that incidentally started the Gold Rush of 1874. They continue on with tales of the infamous Jack McCall and end with present time history. You will see historical landmarks, points of interest and the Chinese and Badland sections of town. On the way to the Cemetery, they recount the legendary lives of Wild Bill Hickok, Calamity Jane and Potato Creek Johnny. Book your tour at 605-578-2091. The cost is \$6.00 per person



If you are looking to spend a whole day touring the Black Hills, Mount Rushmore Tours-Fort Hayes Chuckwagon in Rapid City would be a great way to see it all.
